#1 Calhoun Falls State Park, 46 Maintenance shop road, Calhoun Falls, SC 29628

Calhoun Falls State Recreation Area is located on Lake Russell, one of South Carolina's most popular lakes. Get a photo of any Calhoun Falls State Park Sign.

#2 Branchville, 7504 Freedom Rd, Branchville, SC 29432

Located on the southern tip of Orangeburg County, is home to the world's oldest railroad junction. The junction was built in 1828 and ran from Charleston to Branchville. A photo of the Railroad Depot in Branchville

#3 Little Chicago, 1301 Mt Lebanon rd, Campobello, SC

The community had once had a reputation for illicit liquor manufacturing and sales, earning it the moniker Little Chicago. Corner of Lebanon Road and Goodjoin road. 35.062616 -82.183723

#4 Poinsett State Park, 6660 Poinset park road, Wedgefield, SC 29168

The park is best known for its botanical oddities, combining the flora of the Blue Ridge Mountains foothills and Piedmont. Any sign with the Poinset State Park name on it

#5 Yonce Mill, Mount Calvary road, Spring Ridge, SC 29129

Old Grist Mill built around 1845 and worked into the 1970's. Get a photo of the Mill

#7 Cheraw SC 29520

In the middle of downtown Cheraw is a very cool 7-ft. tall bronze statue of jazz legend Dizzy Gillespie. Photo of Dizzy Gillespie Statue

#8 Pearl Topiary Gardens, 145 Broad Acres Road, Bishopville, SC

A wonderful display of sculptured plants, photo with Garden in Background.

#9 Vien Quang Buddhist Monastery, 1038-1044 Galway Lane, Clover SC 29710

#10 Metcalf Classic service station at or near 2937 Polkville Rd, Shelby, NC 28150

Get a photo of Station.

#11 Blind Squirrel Brewery, 4716 S Us Hwy 19e, Plumtree, NC 28664

Award winning craft brewery, 5 Bedroom Lodge, Restaurant, Winery, & Disc Golf Course. Get a photo of the Brewery, Newland or Plumtree sign.

#12 Piedmont Cheerwine Bottling Co, 1413 Jake Alexander Blvd S, Salisbury, NC 28146

The original beverage bottle had a paper label till it was replaced by a glass bottle with three cherries on the neck and the Cheerwine name molded into the shoulder. Get a photo of Bottling Company sign or building.

#13 North Carolina Aviation Museum, 2222 Pilots View Rd, Ashboro, NC 27205

Immerse yourself in aviation history!... Get a photo of Museum or Airport sign.

#14 Lake Waccamaw State Park, 1866 State Park DriveLake Waccamaw, NC 28450

Located near the town of Lake Waccamaw, North Carolina. The Lake Waccamaw Depot museum is nearby housed in a 1904 Atlantic coast railroad depot. Exhibits include a 300-year-old Indian canoe and marine fossils. Get a photo of park sign.

#15 Crapetree Falls trailhead sign, Near Little Switzerland, NC

The trailhead is located outside Crabtree Falls Campground at mile marker 339.5 on the Blue Ridge Parkway. Get a photo of the trail head sign.

#16 Thistle Meadow Winery, 102 Thistle Meadow, Laurel Springs, NC

Located just off the Blue Ridge Parkway (milepost 246) in Laurel Springs, North Carolina, A family owned winery just two miles off the Blue Ridge Parkway, featuring small batch hand-crafted wines. A photo of the winery.

#17 John Blue House and Heritage Center 13040 X Way Rd, Laurinburg, NC 28352

Beautiful country feel for any type of picture taking. Touring the John Blue house takes you back in time. Get a photo of the house.

#18 Ava Gardner Museum 325 E Market St, Smithfield, NC 27577

The Ava Gardner Museum holds an extensive collection of artifacts from Ava Gardner's career and private life, spanning over 50 years as a movie star. Photo of Museum.

#19 Parker's Ferry, Parker's Ferry Road, near Winton, NC

A cable ferry located on the Meherrin River near Winton, NC. It is one of three remaining cable ferries left in operation in North Carolina. Parkers ferry road. 36.436121 76.953112 Photo of Ferry.

#20 Saint Paul Mountain Vineyard, 588 Chestnut Gap Road, Hendersonville, NC
