

## GRAND TOUR 2019 DESTINATIONS

- 1 Poinsetta Bridge, near Greenville SC. Poinsett Bridge The oldest bridge in SC, completed in 1820, part of the original road connecting Greenville to Asheville. 2 miles northwest of SC Hwy 11, turn onto old US Hwy 25. Travel 3.2 miles, turn right onto Callahan Mountain Rd. Travel 2.2 miles to bridge. Get photo of bridge.
- 2 Water at Healing Springs, Blackville SC People come here from all over to take water from these artesian wells, which is said to have mystical healing powers 33.39202 81.27368 Get a photo of sign or spring.
- 3 Chester old jail, Chester SC Constructed in 1914, a museum now on McAliley st in Chester. Get a photo of the jail.
- 4 Bluffton Oyster Co, near Hilton Head SC 63 Wharf St, Bluffton, SC, 29910. ... shrimp, crabs and fish at the Bluffton Oyster Company, end of Wharf Street in downtown Bluffton near Hilton Head. Photo of restaurant.
- 5 Greenwood Museum, The Museums provide exhibits related to modern and fine arts, history, science and nature, dinosaurs, engineering and more. 106 Main St, Greenwood, South Carolina 29646. Photo of Museum grounds or sign. Photo of Museum or sign.
- 6 Belton SC. If ever there was a "destination restaurant" worthy of an endless journey, it would be Grits and Groceries! 2440 Due West Hwy, Belton, SC 29627 Picture of Chicken or restaurant sign.
- 7 Millfor Plantation, Millford Plantation is a historic place located on SC 261 west of Pinewood. It bears a striking resemblance to the old Charleston Hotel in Charleston, Photo of house or sign.
- 8 Camden Revelotuinary site. Historic Camden Revolutionary War Site is a national historic district and open-air museum. 222 Broad St, Camden, SC 29020 Photo of sign or one of the Historic Buildings.
- 9 Casar NC Photo Post office building. The ride getting there is the best part of this, great country to ride trough. Photo of Post Office.
- 10 Hendersonville, NC Hot dog world, 226 Kanuga Rd, Hendersonville, NC 28739 Photo of restaurant, eat a Hot dog while you are there.
- 11 Road to Nowhere near Lakeshore NC. Located in Great Smoky Mountains National Park, just outside of Bryson City, NC is a road, that literally goes to nowhere. No, we're not kidding, you follow the road for about 8 miles from Bryson City into the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. Photo of tunnel or sign.
- 12 Hot Springs NC Artisan Gallery Cafe. This is such a cute place in Hot Springs, NC. It is a large gallery with lots of different art, handmade and homemade items. They also have a cafe that sells food, drinks and the BEST ice cream, so they say. Photo of cafe.
- 13 Shangri-La Stone Village. Old NC-86, Prospect Hill, NC. Henry L. Warren was a retired tobacco farmer in 1968 when he began building leprechaun-size buildings in his side yard. He called it Shangri-La, and by the time he died nine years later (at age 84) the miniature town had 27 structures. Photo of village
- 14 Atkinson Milling co. 95 Atkinson Mill Rd, Selma, NC 27576 Atkinson Milling Company is a water-powered gristmill located in Selma, North Carolina in operation since 1757. Photo of the mill.
- 15 Tryon Palace 529 South Front Street, New Bern, NC 28562. Let this museum transport you through time starting from the formation of the coastline and through the people who shaped the history of the region. Photo of palace ot sign.
- 16 The Reed Gold Mine. 9621 Reed Mine Rd, Midland, 28107, NC Reed Gold Mine operated on and off as a gold mine. Mining operations were ended by the Kelly family in 1912. The State of North Carolina opened the property as a State Historic Site in 1977. Photo of sign.
- 17 Sanford NC, 120 Carthage St, Temple Theater Temple continues its long tradition as a cultural center for Lee County and surrounding areas. Photo of the Theater.
- 18 EDEN HISTORICAL MUSEUM 656 Washington Street Eden, NC 27288 The museum will tell the

history of what is now Eden, North Carolina, from Prehistoric times to the the Civil War, textile mills, WWI, the Great Depression, WWII, Korean War, Vietnam War, people, places, events. Pgoto of Museum or sign.

19 Shatley Springs, 407 Shatley Springs Rd, Crumpler, NC. Shatley Springs Inn has served as a landmark destination for many decades. Travelers come to enjoy the country cooking, the famous spring water, and the beautiful mountain scenery. Photo of restaurant or sign.

20 Wadesboro, Ansonia Theatre. 112 South Rutherford Street. The Ansonia Theatre is now open as a community theater and venue for musical, poetic and other theater productions. A combination movie and vaudeville theater, the Ansonia Theatre was built in 1925 and for decades served as the cultural center for Anson county. Photo of the Theatre.
